MONDAY TWILIGHT COMPETITION:

10 Week Competition

PLAYERS:

9 years born 2013, 10 years born 2012, 11 years born 2011, 12 years born 2010, 13 years born 2009 only

No more than (3) REPRESENTATIVE PLAYERS (State or Challenge) in one team can play in this competition.

GAME TIMES:

Monday afternoons – 4.30pm and 5.30pm pending nominations

MONDAY TWILIGHT COMPETITION PLAYER FEES:

\$103 per player

\$55.00 per player for 2nd competition with HDNA (played in the 2022 winter competition and any other player already registered with another NQ association in 2022)

\$48.00 per non-playing member/umpire

TEAM NOMINATION:

TEAM REGISTRATION CARD:

Please refer to the Competitions page on the website and click on the Team Registration Card button. Please note the following:

- a. Team registration card must be completed and emailed to the HDNA Secretary info@hdna.net.au by the due dates
- b. Player registrations are through the Netball Connect app
- c. Teams may register up to 12 players at any one time
- d. No 10 year old player is permitted to play in the Junior competition unless approved by the Executive Committee
- e. Boys up to 12 years are eligible to play (mixed rules DO NOT apply to this age group)
- f. Boys 13 are eligible to play (mixed rules WILL APPLY and their division will be classed as mixed). Please make sure when nominating teams, you note if boys are included in the team
- g. Game times are subject to change by the Executive Committee
- h. FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH THE ABOVE – TEAM PENALTY and LOSS OF POINTS

PLAYER REGISTRATION:

Please refer to the Competitions page on the website and click on the Player Registration button. If you belong to a club, you must register directly with your club. No individual player can register with Netball Connect unless you are a member of a team in a HDNA Competition.

CLUB/TEAM AFFILIATION:

All clubs/teams are required to be members of or affiliated with HDNA in order to play in our competitions. **This form only needs to be completed if you are a new team or club and did not play in our 2022 winter competition.**

Affiliation Membership:

Social Membership \$15.00. Clubs or individual teams are welcome to attend HDNA delegates meetings but are not entitled to vote.

PLAYING REGULATIONS:

NetSetGO 9-year-old girls' and boys' competition

NSG/HDNA Rules:

- Size 5 ball, 10' goal posts
- Full rules as per the AANA Netball Rules
- Alternate centre pass as per the full netball rules
- No parents or coach is allowed to walk up & down the sideline
- No coach is allowed on the court
- Coaches are permitted to umpire the game but must do so fairly for both teams without bias
- Coach umpires must only umpire their half of the court (not both ends)
- **There will be no scoring for this competition**
- 9 Years receive a participation award.

NetSetGO 10-year-old girls' and boys' competition

NSG Rules:

- All games will be UMPIRE YOUR OWN.
- Size 5 ball, 10' goal posts
- Full rules as per the AANA Netball Rules
- Coaches cannot umpire their own team
- Alternate centre pass as per the full netball rules
- No parents or coach is allowed to walk up & down the sideline
- No coach is allowed on the court

10 YEARS TO 13 YEARS COMPETITION:

10yrs / 11yrs / 12yrs / 13yrs – 1st and 2nd in each division receive a trophy/medallion.

9 Years receive a participation award.

SCORING WILL BE DONE FOR 10YRS – 13 YRS ONLY:

1 scorer from each team must stand together the whole game. The paper score sheet is the definitive score that will be recorded in the office. All score boards are to be collected and returned via the Competition window. General enquiries or players needing to sign on as they are filling in for a team, can all be done through the office window.

PLAYING REGULATIONS:

No more than 3 representative players in one team. No 10-year-old player can register and play with a junior team (11 years and older) as per our By-Laws, unless they were already registered and played with an older age team in the HDNA winter competition, as approved by the HDNA Executive Committee.

FILL IN PLAYERS may play **ONE GAME ONLY** prior to paying registration and insurance provided they **SIGN ON** in the office on the **TEMPORARY REGISTRATION CARD** and **SIGN THE SCORE SHEET** before taking the court. Prior to playing their second competition game, players **MUST COMPLETE** the official **TEAM REGISTRATION CARD** where registration and insurance **MUST BE PAID** before taking the court. The first game played shall be classified as a qualifying game for the final series of games. A maximum of 2 players per team per game may register on the TEMPORARY REGISTRATION CARD. **FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH THE ABOVE: TEAM PENALTY - LOSS OF POINTS MATCH AWARDED TO THE OPPOSING TEAM.**

10 TO 13 YEARS COMPETITION - UMPIRE YOUR OWN:

All games will be **UMPIRE YOUR OWN**. No Coach or Parent is permitted to umpire their own game. Umpires will be organised via your Club Umpire Coordinator. All umpires must have completed and passed the AANA online umpires' exam and attended the HDNA Basic Umpires Courses before they can umpire any game for your club. If you have a complaint about your club's umpire, please see your Club Umpire Convenor or Club President.

WET WEATHER RULE:

Clubs/teams are requested to advise of intention to forfeit by 5.00pm Sunday night prior to your Monday afternoon game. Forfeits must be sent via the HDNA mobile phone only - 0438 639168. **No forfeits will be accepted via email.** The opposing team will be notified of a forfeit by one text message to the Club President or Team Captain only.

UNIFORMS:

- a) All players in a team must wear identical uniforms as per their Team Affiliation form
- b) Boys to wear shorts
- c) Sports shoes and socks must be worn.
- d) A matching set of bibs must be worn whilst playing
- e) Soft visor only can be worn during games. No hard hats will be allowed
- f) No jewellery is permitted except a wedding ring which must be taped
- g) All body jewellery must be removed **no taping** allowed

- h) Fingernails must be cut short – **not taped** OR approved gloves worn (approved gloves available for sale in the office)
- i) Taping of earrings is strictly **NOT PERMITTED**
- j) **FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH THE ABOVE – PLAYERS WILL BE SENT FROM THE COURT**

UNIFORM REQUIREMENTS BY CLUBS/INDEPENDENT TEAMS:

Each Club/Independent team must register their club/team colours and uniform with the Association at the commencement of each year on completion of the HDNA Affiliation form. New colours and/or changes of colours must be approved before purchasing new uniforms. This is to ensure no two clubs/teams are the same for recognition of your club/team and assistance to umpires.

Uniforms must all be identical in colour/style – Skirts/dresses/shorts must all be the same length including bike pants. Shirts may vary from no sleeves or short sleeves providing they match and are the same colour.

HDNA CODES OF BEHAVIOUR & CONDUCT:

All spectators must abide by the HDNA Codes of Behaviour & Conduct as per our Members Policy. HDNA has zero tolerance to swearing, abusive language and unsportsmanlike behaviour on and off the court. HDNA will not hesitate to remove players and/or spectators from the courts if inappropriate behaviour occurs.

COMPLAINTS:

The correct procedure for any complaints is as follows:

All complaints are to be in writing to your Club President or Team Captain first, NOT HDNA. Your Club President or Team Captain will then forward a letter of complaint without delay, addressed to the HDNA Executives via email info@hdna.net.au. The HDNA Complaints Officer will determine if any action is to be taken. Any complaint received at HDNA without going through the correct channels will be forwarded back to your Club President or Team Captain to action first.
